## HKSH Christmas Party 2014 in Benefit of Operation Santa Claus Jump Rope Challenge, Skipping for Health, Love and Charity

(22 January, 2015 – Hong Kong) Hong Kong Sanatorium & Hospital has for the sixth consecutive years supported the Operation Santa Claus (OSC), an annual charity campaign jointly organised by Radio Television Hong Kong (RTHK) Radio 3 and South China Morning Post (SCMP). With its dollar-for-dollar donation, this year HKSH has raised nearly HK\$680,000 for 20 local beneficiaries serving in six sectors: Children and Youth, Community Service, Elderly Care, Environmental Protection, Healthcare and Support for the Disabled.

The OSC month was kicked off in HKSH with a one-month Jump Rope Challenge, which won "The Most Creative Fundraiser Award" of OSC 2014. "It is our 6<sup>th</sup> year supporting the OSC," said Dr. Joseph CHAN, Deputy Medical Superintendent of HKSH and Chairman of HKSH Village Volunteers. "We began to invite our doctors and staff members to join the Jump Rope Challenge in November 2014, in which each participant had to skip rope for 30 seconds and then challenge another to do the same. The Challenge was more than a fund-raising event; it also set out to promote the spirit of 'give and take' and raise staff awareness of the disadvantaged in the community."

Our 1,000 staff members participated in the one-month Challenge. Leaving their gowns behind with sleeves rolled high, members of the Hospital Management, doctors and nurses took up the Challenge and skipped with joy and laughter. A total of 4 awards were set up for those with most skips within the 30-second period, the best skipping moves, most nominations for challenge and the most creative outfit. Finalists were invited to the ultimate challenge at the OSC Christmas Party. This year "The Best Costume Award" went to a skipper in a hilarious nursing outfit, and with 90 and 89 jumps two colleagues from the Department of Diagnostic & Interventional Radiology and the Department of Ophthalmology won "The Best Record Award" in Male and Female groups respectively. A staff member of 20/F ward was also given "The Best Performance Award" for her high-speed leg-crossing jumps. In the finale of the event, representatives from all departments took part in a 3-hour ropejumping relay at the OSC Christmas Party, showering their support for OSC in sweat and donations.

'Christmas is a festival of love and joy," said Dr. Walton LI, Medical Superintendent of HKSH. "We feel delighted to radiate positive energy and raise donations for the needy in the community with the Jump Rope Challenge. It is also a boost to our unity and team spirit."



This year's Christmas Party continued to feature other fundraising activities, such as "Super Chef in Love" and the Cooking Competition. Dr. Walton LI, Dr. LIANG Hin Suen Raymond, Assistant Medical Superintendent of HKSH, Ms. Manbo MAN, Director of Nursing Services of HKSH, Dr. CHAN Chor Man and Dr. WAI Yuk Chun Veronica put on their aprons as Super Chefs and tried their hand at pancake making to raise funds for OSC, affirming in action HKSH's commitment to the wellbeing of the community.
